April 19 – 22, 2017, Budapest, Hungary

Overview

The 2017 Meeting of the European Public Choice Society will be held from **April 19 – 22, 2017** at the Central European University's School of Public Policy in **Budapest, Hungary**. The European Public Choice Society promotes scientific research on the economics and politics of public and non-market decision-making, political economy and the economics of institutions. About 250 researchers from different fields such as economics, political science and other social sciences meet annually to discuss the current issues in all fields of Public Choice.

Submission of Papers

Empirical, experimental, and theoretical papers will be considered. Please submit **full papers** via the online submission form ([here](#)), starting from **September 1, 2016**. The deadline for submission is **November 30, 2016**. Decisions will be made by **January 15, 2017**.

Conference Venue

The conference will be held at the School of Public Policy at the Central European University in Budapest, Hungary. Liszt Ferenc International Airport in Budapest has direct flights from most European capitals and offers easy access to central Budapest. It is also possible to arrive via international rail services to Nyugati or Keleti stations.

To qualify for the prize, the presenter of the paper as well as all co-authors must be under 30 years of age as of December 31, 2016.
